Training goals

- Improving listening and comprehension skills: Developing trainees' ability to understand spoken English in various contexts, from everyday conversations to academic presentations.
- Improving speaking skills: Empowering trainees to express themselves confidently and clearly in English.
- 3. Improving reading skills: Developing the ability to read English texts with understanding and evaluation, whether academic, literary, or journalistic.
- 4. Improving writing skills: Empowering trainees to write complete, precise, and organized texts in English, whether letters, reports, or articles.
- Improving grammar skills: Enabling trainees to construct sentences and write grammatically correct texts, as well as the ability to understand the context of speech and its meaning based on fundamental grammatical rules.



Target groups

- 1. Youth aged 18 to 35: for university students or recent graduates seeking to develop their language skills.
- 2. Students in upper primary and secondary school who wish to improve their language skills and prepare for university.

Course Introduction

A comprehensive course to learn English explicitly designed to meet the needs of ambitious young people who wish to master the English language. The course lasts 6 months (100-120 training hours) and covers all language levels, starting from beginners (A1) to advanced learners (C2).

The importance of the course:

Developing comprehensive language skills, preparing for assessment exams, increasing self-confidence, and expanding job opportunities.

Target groups:

- Youth aged 18 to 35 and upper primary and secondary school students.
- Course advantages: modern and diverse curricula with qualified teaching staff.

Expected results:

- Mastery of the English language: By the end of the course, the trainee will be able to speak fluently, understand, read, and write in English with confidence.
- Passing the exams: The trainee will be eligible to receive a certified diploma proving their English proficiency.
- Expanding Future Horizons: The course will open new doors for education, employment, and migration trainees.

Notes:

- Integration between the axes: The different axes are integrated, so the skills acquired in each axis are applied to the other axes.
- Diversity in activities: Various appropriate activities and teaching techniques are used for online technology to ensure trainee engagement and motivate them to learn.
- Continuous assessment: Ongoing evaluation of trainees' progress is conducted to identify their strengths and weaknesses.
- Focusing on individual needs: Each trainee's needs are considered, and the necessary support is provided.

This distribution is tailored to the specific needs of each course, focusing on the skills that trainees require the most. Example:

- If the course is aimed at beginners, the hours for the first and second components (listening and reading) are increased to establish a strong foundation for the essential skills.
- If the course is aimed at individuals who wish to improve their speaking skills, the hours for the fourth module (speaking) will be increased, and activities focusing on daily conversations and presentations will be included.
